






Everglades Restoration Transition Plan (Phase I)



Goals

- Conserve multi-species in the transition to full Everglades restoration
- Modify the current operational regime in Water Conservation Area 3 with the latest science
- Use real-time information to improve conditions with the flexibility available today
- Take incremental steps toward restoration and monitor to improve future operational plans


Everglades Restoration Transition Plan (Phase I)



Current Status

- Team currently reviewing the full suite of operational flexibilities in order to recommend a plan
- Other ERTTP phases may incorporate additional flexibilities
- On schedule to meet November 2010 deadline





Schedule

- Meet with partners to discuss options: April-June 2010
- Evaluate alternatives and identify Tentatively Selected Plan: June-July 2010
- Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS): August 2010
- Biological Opinion: October 2010
- Final EIS and Record of Decision: January 2011
