The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and our partners, the South Florida Water Management District, the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, cordially invite you to attend the groundbreaking ceremony for the Site 1 Impoundment/Fran Reich Preserve project being held October 29 at 10 a.m.

This project is yet another milestone in Everglades Restoration. Funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, this \$44 million contract for Phase One was awarded to a Florida firm and is putting Floridians to work. It will increase much needed water storage capacity and water management flexibility adjacent to the Arthur R. Marshall Loxahatchee National Wildlife Refuge.
