



Water Resources Reform and Development Act (WRRDA) of 2014, Section 6001 – Project Deauthorization

Purpose

To identify Water Resources Development Projects Authorized for construction that are eligible for deauthorization per criteria specified in Section 6001 of WRRDA 2014.

Interim Deauthorization List Criteria

- Authorized construction projects or separable elements of a construction project
- Project authorized pre-WRDA 2007
- No Construction funds obligated from fiscal years 2009 – 2015
- No funds for a Post Authorization Change Report from fiscal years 2009-2015



Interim Deauthorization List

- Identified \$14,300,000,000 in eligible projects
- Interim Deauthorization List submitted to Congress: September 26, 2015
- Letter sent to Governors of States with projects on the Interim Deauthorization List
- Published in the Federal Register - Initiated 90 day public comment period - October 7, 2015 to January 4, 2016



Final Deauthorization Report Preparation

- Up To 120 days to develop Final Deauthorization Report: January 5, 2016 – May 4, 2016
- No discretion to remove projects from the Final Deauthorization Report
- Submit Final Deauthorization Report to Congress - Publish report in Federal Register



Congressional Action

- Congress has 180 days to pass a joint resolution disapproving the Final Deauthorization Report: May 5, 2016 – October 31, 2016
- Projects in the Final Deauthorization Report are automatically deauthorized if no joint resolution of Senate and House is passed



Non-Federal Interest Option

- Before the 180th day of Congressional action, non-Federal interests can elect to provide sufficient funds to the Corps to complete the construction of a project
