Results will be reported to the Working Group after the initial NEAT organizational meeting. The report by Carol Goodyear was sent to the three appointed members for review.

NEWTT is meeting May 28 & 29, 2003 in the next step toward developing the full implementation plan through CERP. CERP funding is providing sufficient funds to develop a RECON type report outlining the federal role in invasive plant management for Everglades restoration and NEWTT will be working with the COE to develop the RECON report and complete the implementation plan in concert with this report as both documents have many of the same components.
