# Background

- At the July 7, 2022, Working Group/Science Coordination Group meeting, the US Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) formally requested a public workshop on the updated Integrated Delivery Schedule (IDS).
- This formal request was in addition to the blanket approval of annual IDS workshops provided by the Working Group in 2021.

# Background

- The Task Force and Working Group have a history of coordination and public engagement for the IDS.
- The Task Force and Working Group helped coordinate the development of the initial IDS in 2008 and sponsored public engagement workshops for the 2011 and 2015 updates.
- Annual public engagement workshops have been sponsored by the Task Force since 2019.

# Workshop Format

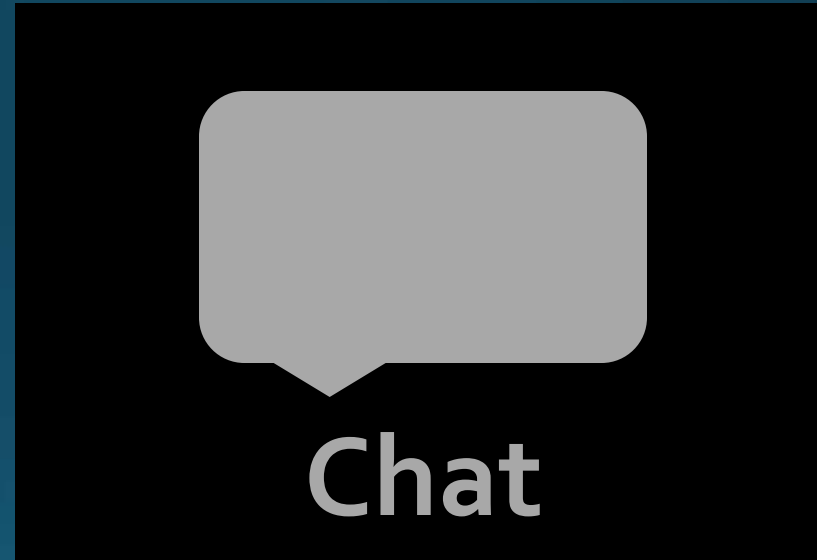
- This workshop is designed to:
  - Add value for the public and agencies involved in Everglades restoration.
  - Provide planning and technical information to the public.
  - Facilitate two-way dialogue between the public and staff.
- The results of the workshop will be formally transmitted to the Corps and South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD).

  - **Public Comment: Oral comments** can be provided at the conclusion of the workshop with the **Raise Hand** feature.

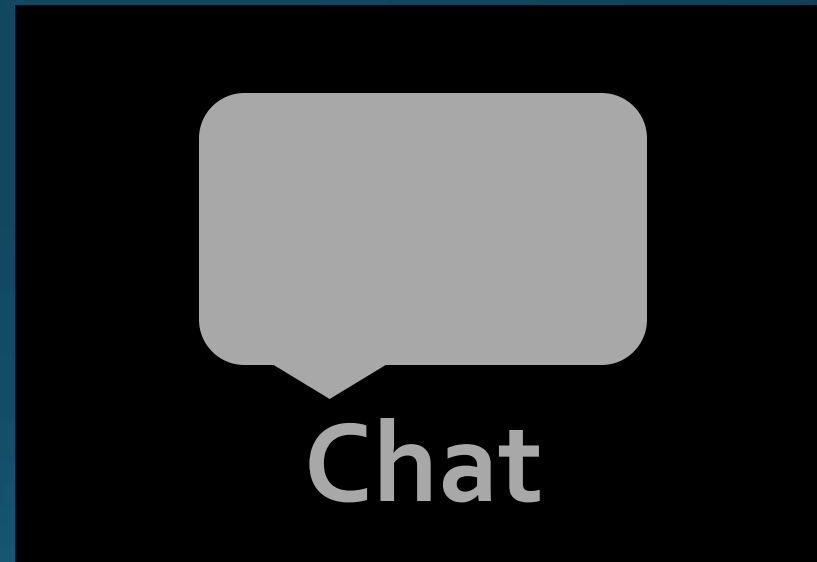
# Q&A Session via Chat

- At the beginning of the public comment period, click the Raise Hand icon at the bottom of your screen if you'd like to speak.
