- Completed Final Project Implementation Report on Broward County Water Preserve Areas, Approved by Civil Works Review Board
- Backfilling of Toe Ditch on Herbert Hoover Dike in Reach 1 continues
- Issued solicitation notices for both Seepage Berm and Cutoff Wall on HHD
- Public Meeting held on Real Estate EIS for Tamiami Trail
- Published Draft report on C-43 for review

- ENP Seepage Management FSM held
- Awarded contract on Kissimmee River for modification to Lake Istokpoga Outlet.
- Awarded S-333 Modifications at lower end of WCA 3A
- Completed Administration Review of Picayune Strand PIR and transmitted report to Congress
- Interim Goals and Targets Agreement signed – 27 April
