

# LAND ACQUISITION TEAM UPDATE

The Land Acquisition Team met on Monday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, to discuss the draft plan outline and data compilation/format. The next meeting will be scheduled during the week of June 11<sup>th</sup>.

## Land Acquisition Plan Outline

### Main Report:

Three categories of lands will be addressed in the main part of the report. All land acquisition projects must have an identified federal or joint interest in acquisition. The main report will consist of text and a map depicting the following:

- 1- ACQUIRED LANDS: Lands in existing CARL/SOR/local projects already acquired that are in the footprint of a federal or joint project.
  - a. CERP
  - b. Other federal/joint projects (e.g. Kissimmee Restoration, non-CERP Critical Projects)
- 2- NEEDED LANDS: Additional lands estimated to be needed for specific project implementation.
  - a. CERP - Lands associated with a specific CERP project component with a scheduled implementation date.
  - b. Other federal/joint projects - Lands associated with a specific project with a scheduled implementation date.
- 3- POTENTIAL LANDS: Additional potential conservation lands that federal agencies are interested in acquiring but that are not currently funded or specifically identified.

### Appendix I

This appendix will contain a summary table and Data Sheet Profiles for the lands identified in the main part of the report (similar to Volume II of "Coordinating Success").

### Appendix II

This appendix will contain text and maps regarding complementary land acquisition programs that are not part of a federal or joint project, e.g., local or state government acquisition projects that do not have federal participation.
