

# New DECOMP Proposal Committee

## Overview of TF request and proposed timelines

I. At the September Task Force meeting, Kameran Onley asked the Executive Director to establish a committee to review the “Bold Decomp” proposal presented by George Dunlop and Dennis Duke and report back to the Task Force at its meeting in Key West on December 6-7. The afternoon of the first day of the December TF meeting is a joint meeting with the WRAC.

Dennis Duke and Rock Salt have been appointed as the committee co chairs. Any interested member of the Working Group or Science Coordination Group is invited to be a member of the committee. The meetings will be publicly noticed and will include opportunities for public comment. The committee will also provide status updates to the regularly scheduled meetings of the Working Group and Science Coordination Group prior to the final presentation to the Task Force in December.

The committee is being established to:

- Provide feedback on the concept to the Task Force in December
- Provide for public participation and comment
- Help the Corps refine its concept
